

On arrival.. Please go to the Conference Centre door of number 16 Norham Gardens. This is on your left as you face the front door of number 16. In the unlikely event that you, and not the trainer, are the first to arrive, please go to the front door of number 14 Norham Gardens.

FOOD and DRINK

OCTS courses have always been low-cost. One of the ways this has been achieved is by asking participants to provide their own lunch.

When finding a venue from which to run OCTS courses the proximity to shops, cafes and pubs is always a consideration. The decision to host OCTS courses at Norham Gardens was made in the full knowledge that there is nowhere close by to buy food. It was agreed that despite this the Cherwell Centre, in almost every other way, is ideal and the Executive Committee are delighted that OCTS courses are to be run from there.

The closest shops are at Little Clarendon Street, which is over half a mile away (12 minute walk) and North Parade is a mile and a quarter away, which is about a 20 minute walk. In view of this, when you attend OCTS courses, you are strongly advised to

TAKE A PACKED LUNCH!

There are facilities to make hot drinks at the Cherwell Centre. Decaffeinated and regular tea and coffee and herbal teabags, milk, sugar, chilled water and biscuits are all provided.

Disabilities

There is easy wheelchair access at the Cherwell Centre but please let Gina Ball (01235 211038) know in advance if you need to enter the conference centre using level access or have limited mobility or a disability. Please also advise Gina if you have any other special needs of which you feel that OCTS should be aware.

Park and Ride and other buses

Water Eaton Park and Ride

Norham Gardens is off Banbury Road on the route of the Water Eaton Park and Ride bus service.

Buses run between the City Centre and Water Eaton every 20 minutes from 7:40

The journey time is 10 -15 minutes.

The Park and Ride bus stops closest to Norham Gardens are St Margaret's Road and Keble Road.

Parking at Water Eaton is free and the return fare is £2.50 or £4.50 for two adults travelling together.

Other Park and Ride Services

All Park and Ride routes serve the City Centre from which Norham Gardens is about a 25 minute walk or a short bus ride away.

The bus stops in town for these routes are on Magdalen Street near the Odeon Cinema.
